WHY: To make a positive impact with families who would benefit from these toys this holiday season. Some children with developmental or motor delays may not be able to control their arm/hand movements allowing them to play with 'typical' age-appropriate toys. Toys can be modified for use with an activation switch, enabling a child to easily access a toy. These toys can be hard to find and expensive. Families may not have the resources available to acquire these toys, may not know they exist or even how to buy them.
